Job Description

Job Title: Dance Specialist **(to be combined with either Arts & Crafts Specialist or Music Specialist)**

Reports to: Program Directors

Position Purpose: The Dance Specialist is responsible for the development and delivery of a dance program that is appropriate to campers' age and abilities and compliments Camp Krem's philosophies, goals and programs. Assist in the management of the dance area and related equipment and supplies.

Essential Job Functions:

1. Develop and deliver a dance program appropriate for our campers, considering their age, abilities and Camp themes.
 - Design daily dance lesson plans that meet the needs of the campers.
 - Evaluate abilities of campers and adapt lessons accordingly.
 - Implement varied and interactive daily dance sessions.
 - Encourage campers' self-expression and self-confidence through dance.
2. Work with campers throughout the session to prepare for dance performances at end of each session, highlighting what they have learned.
3. Work with interested campers one on one to prepare individual dance performances for Talent Show etc.
4. Assist in the planning of any special events, especially in the area of dance.

Other Job Duties:

- Participate enthusiastically in all camp activities, planning and leading those as assigned
- Participate as a member of the programming team to deliver and supervise daily activities, evening programs, special events, and other all-camp activities and camp functions.
- Reach out to local dance teachers and organize workshops and performances for our campers and staff during the sessions.
- Assist with various other administrative duties as assigned by Directors.
- Abide by all camp policies and procedures.
- Communicate and interact effectively with fellow staff members, administrative staff and campers, regardless of ability, race, creed, national origin, sexual identification or gender.
- Complete and submit all paperwork as required within designated time frames.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years old, preferably with college experience.
- Experienced in a variety of dance genres.
- Supervisory or teaching experiences with children or adults, preferably with special populations
- Current First Aid and CPR Certification, or willingness to obtain.
- Ability to lift 50 pounds.
