Job Description

Job Title: Drama Specialist **(to be combined with either Music Specialist or Arts & Crafts Specialist)**

Reports to: Program Directors

Position Purpose: The Drama Specialist is responsible for the development and delivery of a drama/theater program that is appropriate to campers' age and abilities and compliments Camp Krem's philosophies, goals and programs. Assist in the management of the drama area and related equipment and supplies.

Essential Job Functions:

1. Develop and deliver a music program appropriate for our campers, considering their age, abilities and Camp themes.
 - Design daily drama lesson plans that meet the needs of the campers.
 - Evaluate abilities of campers and adapt lessons accordingly.
 - Implement varied and interactive daily drama sessions.
 - Encourage campers' self-expression and self-confidence through drama.
2. Work with campers throughout the session to prepare for final drama performance.
3. Work with interested campers one-on-one to prepare individual performances for Talent Show etc.
4. Assist in the planning of any special events especially in the area of theater.

Other Job Duties:

- Participate enthusiastically in all camp activities, planning and leading those as assigned
- Participate as a member of the programming team to deliver and supervise daily activities, evening programs, special events, and other all-camp activities and camp functions.
- Assist with various other administrative duties as assigned by Directors.
- Ensure the safe storage of supplies and equipment throughout and at the end of the season.
- Maintain organization and cleanliness of costume closet and costumes.
- Abide by all camp policies and procedures.
- Complete and submit all paperwork within designated time frame.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years old, preferably with college experience.
- Able to play one or more instruments.
- Supervisory or teaching experiences with children or adults, preferably with special populations
- Current First Aid and CPR Certification, or willingness to obtain.
- Physical ability to respond appropriately to situations requiring first aid. Must be able to assist campers in an emergency (fire, evacuation, illness, or injury) and possess strength and endurance required to maintain constant supervision of campers.
